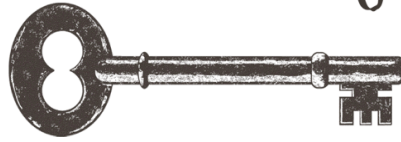

Second Street Cuvée Santa Barbara County

Our new release of the Second Street Cuvée is a blend of Syrah, Grenache and Mourvèdre from a group of vineyards, throughout the county, that show off the beautiful, earthy fruit quality Rhone varietals take on in this ideal location. Because the blend is dominated by Syrah this year and because it was a good year for dark, rich Syrah, this wine has substantially more heft than last year's wine. Despite that, the 2015 Second Street holds true to our goal of making a wine that is round and soft and ready for drinking right on release. It will cellar beautifully for a decade or longer but who can wait!

***Tasting Note:** The Syrah is obvious here as the color is a dark purple-ish red. Aromas of dark fruit and violets mixed with tar and tobacco and freshly cracked black pepper make for a distinctly complex nose. On the pallet, the wine is full bodied but is well framed by enough juicy acidity to keep it fresh and lively. There are velvety tannins this year that make the finish linger on your palate. This will pair nicely with your grill this summer as I see burgers, steaks and rich lamb chops as the ideal partners for this wine.*
